

COMMITTEE ON MINISTRY

The purpose of the Committee on Ministry is to support the spiritual health and wellbeing of the entire Congregation, as seen in member participation and accomplishment relative to the mission of the Congregation. Its primary responsibilities are to assess both the professional ministers' ministries and the Congregation's collective ministries in order to strengthen the quality of these ministries, ~~and to provide conflict management and resolution when necessary.~~

A Committee on Ministry of ~~five~~ **at least three (3)** members shall be appointed by the Board ~~of trustees in consultation with the Spiritual Leader~~ for staggered terms of three years. New members of the Committee shall begin their terms on July 1, and terms shall rotate in a 2-2-1 pattern.

Members of the Committee on Ministry shall be members of the Congregation. ~~Meetings of The~~ Committee on Ministry shall ~~be~~ meet in Executive Session. The professional minister shall serve as an *ex officio* member of the Committee. Any member wishing to discuss a concern at a Committee on Ministry meeting shall contact the Committee to schedule that item on the agenda.

New members for the Committee on Ministry will be selected ~~for nomination to~~ by the Board ~~of Trustees by the Leadership Development Committee~~ with consideration of such factors as length of UUCGT membership, gender, participation, experience, interest, listening ability, impartiality, fair mindedness and good heart with a goal of providing balance to the composition ~~of~~ the existing Committee.

~~The Leadership Development Committee, in consultation with the Committee on Ministry and the settled minister, will prepare a list of at least three names, guided by the above mentioned characteristics, and present those names to the Board of Trustees for final selection.~~

Committee on Ministry members may simultaneously serve on other Congregational committees but not simultaneously serve on the Board of Trustees. Member may not serve more than two consecutive terms on the Committee on Ministry and must maintain a minimum of two years before returning to the Committee.
