The Facilities Committee believes that we need an out-door storage building for our gasoline engine lawn mower, snow blower and weed whip.

We would also store non-motorized tools in this unit as well as watering equipment and hoses.

It is dangerous to store the gasoline items in the furnace portion of the basement because of the fire hazard. In general, the equipment has been emptied of gasoline when they are in the basement. However, it is very inconvenient to use the weed whip in this manner. We are reluctant to have it out-of-doors as it might be damaged or stolen.

We have shopped at two businesses and have decided that we would like a 8' x 12' storage unit that retails for \$1,870. In addition, we will need some crushed rock and cement blocks at the corners.
