MUSIC DIRECTOR

The Music Director at UUCGT nurtures and facilitates music as an integral part of our congregation's intellectual and spiritual life.

The person hired for this position will have a background in choral conducting in a school or church environment, as well as basic piano skills.

The Music Director is hired by the UUGCT Board of Trustees and reports to the Minister.

The responsibilities of the Music Director include:

- Planning music (vocal, instrumental) for Sunday Services, special occasions, etc, in collaboration with the Minister, The Sunday Services Committee, invited speakers, and special events committees
- 2. Coordinating, overseeing, and rehearsing with the Vocal Ensemble and other musicians on a regular basis
- 3. Planning and coordinating 1-2 All Music Services per year
- 4. Maintaining the musical assets of the congregation
- 5. Managing the music related budget as determined by the Board that includes submitting an annual budget
- Attending Sunday Services Committee meetings (voting member),
 Board Meetings (non voting member) when music related issues are
 being discussed, and Music Committee meetings
- 7. Knowledge of current copyright law as it pertains to selected musical inclusions (vocal, instrumental)
- 8. Providing regular submissions to the Flash and Beacon
- 9. Attending and participating in denominational activities and organizations, as able, such as the UU Musicians Network
