There was a bake sale table, with baked goods donated from Congregation.

There were 2 tables of books we got from AAU from Skinner House and Beacon Press.

There was a table with information on immigrant issues and opportunity for attendees to donate- JFON (Justice for our Neighbors) and JPAC (Justice and Peace Advocacy Center).

On Oct 27 there was a Fall Festival held by RE at the same time.

Marketing was done with Facebook posts and boost. There was an ad in the Classifieds of Northern Express for both weeks. Flyers posted around town. Street signs put out Oct 18. Red pendant flag put out by the street on Oct 27.

A very big thank you to all that helped with the Art, Book, and Bake sale we had Oct 20 & 27. I don't want to start naming names and then miss someone. Thank you to our bakers, vendors, set up crew, take down crew, advertising, woodworker who donated table made from a UUCGT piano, book sale organizers, assisted with Hospitality, book and baked good sellers, advertising flyer creator and distributor, street sign creator, library book donator, vendor who donated a portion of their sales and all the buyers.

We raised about \$998 with the bake and vender tables after expenses and got 6 books for the library. The book sale was a total bust and we lost money.

## THE NUMBERS

**BOOKS** **-\$489.83\***

\$1689.70 (books) + \$75 (shipping) = \$1764.70

Credit \$37.90 originally charged us full price, credited that, then charged discounted price

Charge \$22.74 Balance \$1749.54

Credit for Returned Books \$1231.35

Shipping for Returned Books \$64.93

Cost for damaged books \$252.48

Cost to ship damaged books to us \$25

Profit for UUCGT \$60.29 – \$550.12 = -\$489.83

\*If we sell most of the damaged books we can recoup up to about \$275

**Books for UUCGT library (6) \$60.54 – \$40 donation = -\$20.54 from profit**
