## Defining MEMBER and FRIEND terms

Membership is open to all sixteen (16) years of age or older who find value in the purpose of this Congregation and have signified their commitment by signing the membership register in the presence of the Minister or a Board member. Membership is open to all without regard to race, color, gender, disability, sexual orientation, gender expression, class or national origin. Members actively support the operation of the Congregation through attendance, service, and an annual pledge commitment. Members shall be entitled to all rights and privileges of membership immediately, except that the right to vote shall take effect four (4) weeks after signing the register.
